B5.06 - Risk Module (binding orders)

1. If we reduce or cancel a credit limit or an @rating limit for a buyer, our cover will be maintained for the deliveries, shipments or services that you are obliged to make or perform during the six months following the date of our notice.

1.1 This cover is subject to the following conditions:

- These deliveries, shipments or services must be made or performed pursuant to
 - (i) a sales contract entered into less than six months before the date of our notice,
 - or
 - (ii) a schedule of deliveries, shipments or services which have been agreed upon with the buyer less than six months before the date of our notice, from which you cannot be contractually released
- The buyer concerned cannot be insolvent nor overdue for more than sixty days.

2. It is your responsibility to determine whether you are contractually committed. This means that in the event you fail to make or perform such deliveries, shipments or services, your buyer would be entitled to take action against you for breach of contract or seek other legal redress. However, if your sales contract entitles you to cease deliveries, shipments or services in permitted circumstances and those circumstances apply, then you are not contractually committed.

In the event of a claim

we will require you to provide evidence of your contractual commitment and to submit a copy of your sales contract, purchase orders and acknowledgment orders and any other documentation we may deem necessary.
